



# Painting Senior Parking Spaces



This is available for all Lakeview High School Seniors that have a valid parking pass for the 2019-2020 school year. Students will have the opportunity to select and personalize a parking space in a designated area of the Auditorium Parking lot. This will be theirs throughout the entire school year between the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. on school days.

## Important Information – Cost, Selection, Dates and Times

- Cost per parking spot is **\$25**. This is a fundraiser for the Senior All Night Party (SANP) and Prom.
- **Selection of your parking spot** will be available during Registration/Schedule Pick up on **August 29<sup>th</sup>** beginning at 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. on a first come, first serve basis at the SANP table. A map of the designated area with numbered spots will be available to review and select. Lakeview parking pass forms will also be available at that time.
- If you are unable to select/pay for your spot during registration, selection and purchase will also be available at the following events:
  - **9/6/19 – Home football game**
  - **9/12/19 – SANP Meeting**
- Upon receipt of your payment you will receive a design form. The **design form is due** to the office no later than **September 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>** for approval. Your parking pass must also be on file in the office by this date.
- Painting days will be **Saturday, September 21<sup>st</sup> 12pm – 5pm and Sunday September 22<sup>nd</sup> 1pm – 5pm**

## Guidelines/Criteria for your Design Form

- You **MUST** complete the attached design form/drawing **in color** to be able to design your spot. The sketch will be reviewed and approved by Mr. Kapla to ensure appropriate content.
- Think of your space as a t-shirt you would wear to school. It must be dress code appropriate. Keep it classy. Think about things that describe you or reflect your interests; such as a hobby, an instrument you play, family, a sport, school spirit, jersey number, favorite quote or slogan, something unique about you or simply an interesting or creative design. Check out Pinterest or Google images for ideas.
- Design criteria:
  - No offensive language or gang symbols
  - No double meanings
  - No advertising or symbols of alcohol, drugs, violence or obscene slogans
  - No promotion of illegal activities or gestures
  - Your spot must include your first and last name

## Paint Requirements

- **Only Latex paint – Interior or Exterior – water based!!**
  - ❖ **No spray paint, No oil based paints, no reflective paint**

- All Paint, brushes, rollers, pans, rags etc must be provided by the student.
- Do not paint over the yellow parking lines
- Leave 2 inch border between design and yellow parking lines – use painters tape for this!
- Clean up is the responsibility of the student. Bring garbage bags to transport used equipment home.
- Broom to sweep spot
- drop cloth to put under paint cans
- Optional:
  - Plastic containers for water and brushes (ie: coffee can)
  - Sunscreen, hats, sunglasses, water, snacks
  - Stool or towel to sit on
  - Umbrella/tent for shade

## Painting Tips

- Paint can be expensive!
  - We are trying to work with the local Sherwin Williams about obtaining a discount for this event. We will post to Facebook and Remind with this information.
  - Ask family and neighbors if they have any leftover exterior paint you can use.
  - Home supply stores usually have paint in clearance or “oopsy” paint available at discounted prices.
  - Talk to your friends about what colors they are using and share.
  - Simplify your design.
- Tape the edges of your spot with a 2 inch margin from yellow lines before painting.
- Do not paint on the yellow lines or parking lot curbs.
- Sweep the dirt and pebbles off the spot.
- Use chalk to draw out your sketch.
- Start painting at the front of your spot out to the end (front bumper to back bumper)..others working beside you and you cannot step on their spot.
- Consider make a stencil ahead of time for lettering or detailed images to save a lot of time.
- Limit your paint palette as the quarts of paint are expensive.
- It will take 2 quarts of paint to cover the spot if you are using a solid color


